A Word from our Manager

The Bishop's Stortford Squash Club would like to take this opportunity to welcome you all and thank you for entering the BAA London Stansted British Under 19/15 Championships 2006. Please take a few minutes to read the following information, which we hope, will be of use to you and help make your tournament more enjoyable.

VENUES and COURTS

Please check carefully the venue and court you have been allocated for each of your games as some matches will be held at The Chantry Squash Club. Courts Jetta, Passat, Touareg, Golf and Touran are situated at The Bishop's Stortford Squash Club whilst courts Polo and Fox are situated at The Chantry Squash Club.

CAR PARKING

Car parking may be limited at Silver Leys from 1pm on Saturday and between 9am and 12pm on Sunday. Alternative parking is available at The Chantry Squash Club and Bishops Stortford Lawn Tennis Club, both of which are situated in Cricketfield Lane. Please ask one of our attendants who will be happy to direct you.

VOLUNTEERS

We have a large number of volunteers on hand to help who are easily identifiable by their orange shirts. Should you have any queries throughout the event please feel free to ask for assistance.

BAGS, KIT etc.

Please ensure that squash bags are not taken into the marquee or upstairs in the club as they may obstruct walkways, passages or fire exits. All bags should be checked in with a baggage handler located on court 5. Any unattended bags will be removed and taken to court 5.

CLUB SHOP

Squash equipment will be available from the club shop throughout the event. In addition grips and squash balls are available from the vending machine situated on the ground floor outside the Touareg Court.

LOST PROPERTY

Having many years of experience trying to retrieve rackets, goggles, shoes etc, all items of lost property handed in will be sent to court 5 for re-claim. It would greatly help the organisers if items of value could be named to assist in re-uniting them with their owner.

RACKET STRINGING

A racket stringing service is available at the club throughout the event; please ask at the tournament desk or one of our volunteers for details.

CATERING

A selection of both hot and cold food will be available throughout the day from 8am – 5pm from the events marquee. After 5pm food will be available from the club bar. There is also a "tuck shop" situated on court 5.

Our licensed bar will be open for liquid refreshments throughout the tournament serving tea and coffee, soft drinks etc. It would be appreciated if you could please return your empty glasses to the bar.

LITTER

Please respect our facilities by placing all drinks cans, empty packets etc. in the litterbins provided.

TOILETS

Additional toilet facilities are located outside by the marquee.

FIRST AID

In case of injury please report to the tournament desk for details of local practitioners and accident and emergency departments.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Please read the fire and emergency instructions notices and note the location of fire exits within the club.
